Anyone interested in working or volunteering for the Lakewood Police Department must take a polygraph examination. The polygraph examination is performed by Amich and Jenks, Inc., and is in compliance with state and federal laws, including the Americans with Disabilities Act. The following are topic areas covered by the polygraph examiner:

1. Job history
2. Military history
3. Financial history
4. Driving history
5. Criminal history
6. Theft from jobs
7. Other relevant thefts
8. Buying and selling stolen property
9. Falsification of Lakewood Police Department application or interview process
10. Excessive physical force
11. Paying and receiving bribes
12. Possession and use of illegal drugs or substances
13. Job-related alcohol usage
14. Falsification of official reports or statements
